**BROOKLYN'S FINEST** R Drama 132 minutes  
 Something of a genre homecoming, Antoine Fuqua's latest film once again finds him delving into the gritty, brutal realm of cops and crooks—as he did in *Training Day*. Tango is an undercover officer on a narcotics detail that forces him to choose between duty and friendship. Having been to hell and back, he wants out, but the powers that be won't let him quit. Family-man Sal is a detective tempted by greed and corruption. He can barely make ends meet, and now his wife has an illness that threatens the life of their unborn twins.

**CHLOE** 16 LNS Drama 97 minutes  
 A missed flight...a lack of intimacy...guarded secrets... To Catherine (Julianne Moore), every detail suggests that her husband David (Liam Neeson) has been unfaithful. But there's only one way to know for sure. Catherine pays the mysterious Chloe (Amanda Seyfried), an escort, to seduce her husband. She wants to know exactly how far she can trust him. But soon Catherine finds herself pushed beyond all limits as passions burn and obsessions build.

**FEMALE AGENTS** R Drama 113 minutes  
**French / English sub-titles**  
 This is the story of five French women involved in the resistance movement during the Second World War. Their mission involves the exfiltration of a British secret agent who falls into the hands of the Germans just before the Normandy Landings. These five women, who are far from heroic, become heroines.

**THE GHOST WRITER** PG 13 Thriller 128 minutes  
 When a gifted ghost writer (Ewan McGregor) is hired to write the memoirs of former British Prime Minister Adam Lang (Pierce Brosnan), he quickly finds himself trapped in a web of political and sexual intrigue. Lang is implicated in a scandal over his administration's harsh tactics, and as the ghost writer digs into the politician's past, he discovers secrets that threaten to jeopardize international relations forever. Co-starring Olivia Williams and Kim Cattrall, it is a taut and shocking thriller from acclaimed director Roman Polanski (*The Pianist*).

**THE GIRL WITH THE DRAGON TATTOO** Thriller 152 minutes  
**Swedish / English sub-titles**  
 Forty years ago, Harriet Vanger disappeared from a family gathering on the island owned and inhabited by the powerful Vanger clan. Her body was never found, yet her beloved uncle is convinced it was murder and that the killer is a member of his own tightly knit but dysfunctional family. He employs disgraced financial journalist Mikael Blomkvist (Michael Nyqvist) and the tattooed and troubled but resourceful computer hacker Lisbeth Salander (Noomi Rapace) to investigate.

**LOVE HAPPENS** PG 13 Romantic Comedy 105 minutes  
 Jennifer Aniston and Aaron Eckhart star in the romantic drama *Love Happens*. When self-help author Dr. Burke Ryan (Eckhart) arrives in Seattle to teach a sold-out seminar, he unexpectedly meets florist Eloise Chandler (Aniston), the one person who might be able to help him help himself. But will two people who may have met the right person at exactly the wrong time be able to give love a chance? If they can, they'll find that sometimes, when you least expect it...love happens.

**MY NAME IS KHAN** 13 PG LPV Drama 165 minutes  
 Two of Bollywood's biggest superstars, Shah Rukh Khan and Kajol, deliver powerful performances in this epic romance that proves true love knows no boundaries. Rizwan (Khan), an Indian man with a unique way of looking at the world, moves to San Francisco and meets a vivacious single mother named Mandira (Kajol). They form a special bond and fall in love against all odds, but fate and tragedy conspire to tear them apart. That's when Rizwan embarks on a remarkable journey across America to win back the love of his life.

**NANNY MCPHEE** PG Comedy 97 minutes  
 With hairy warts, a stern-looking unibrow and one extremely protruding buck-tooth, *Nanny McPhee* is a wonderfully comedic substitute for *Mary Poppins* in this entertaining family fantasy. By loosely adapting Christianna Brand's *Nurse Matilda* children's books of the 1960s, Oscar winning screenwriter Emma Thompson (*Sense and Sensibility*) has also given herself the plum role of Nanny McPhee, who can tame even the most unruly children with a tap of her magic walking stick.

**NINE** PG 13 Musical / Drama 113 minutes  
 A vibrant and provocative musical filled with love, lust, passion and glamour. A world famous film director reaches a creative and personal crisis of epic proportion, while balancing numerous women in his life. With its incredible all-star cast, amazing performances, and stunning visuals, this razzle-dazzle extravaganza will make you long to BE ITALIAN.

**SHALL WE DANCE** PG Romantic/ Comedy 106 minutes  
 Golden Globe winner Richard Gere and Jennifer Lopez step out in a delightfully sexy comedy with a sizzling all-star cast! John Clark (Gere) is a meek workaholic who feels trapped in a dull, mind-numbing existence. *Paris 1995*, an exhibition of work in mixed media by Jan Visser, opens at **is art** in Franschhoek on 12 September. This is the first exhibition of Visser's work since his death on 7 September 2009. All the work on show dates from 1995, when Visser was resident for three months at the Cité Internationale des Arts in Paris.

In a career spanning 40 years, Visser, who at the time of his death lived in Paternoster, held more than 30 one-man shows and participated in over 40 group shows, in South Africa, Portugal, Spain and elsewhere. His work is represented in public collections that include Pretoria Art Museum, Sasol, SABC, Absa, Telkom, the Universities of Stellenbosch and the Free State, the former Peninsula Technikon and the William Humphries Museum in Kimberley.
